ACTION NEEDED

Crosswalks: Increased visibility!

- * This is key to implementing a successful Pedestrian Friendly town.
- * Standardizing new striping design throughout Downtown District.

Reducing Speed: Reduce posted speed in Downtown District to 22 mph

- * Fundamental requirements for a 'Pedestrian Friendly' environment.

Do it now! Direct staff to review and prepare a resolution ASAP.





ACTION NEEDED

Way Finding - Signage:

- * Post signs around town showing points of interest.
- * Develop a Historic Downtown Logo/Image.
- * Signage examples:
 - Additional Parking
 - Riverwalk access
 - West side businesses
 - East side businesses
 - Post Office
 - Bike Trails
 - Arboretum
 - Carleton / St.Olaf
 - Rest Rooms

Way Finding - Information Boards:

- * Locate information boards around downtown (4 to 6 boards)
- * Bi-weekly posters
- * Quarterly posters
- * Identify local group to manage
- * Invest in on-demand poster printer
- * Integrate Boards with signage

ACTION NEEDED

Bike Racks:

- * Locate more bike racks, but minimize size
- * Post friendly signs - "Walk, don't ride on sidewalks while downtown."



ACTION NEEDED

Banners:

- * Colorful Banners with new Downtown District logo.
- * Possibility for business identification Art group could provide student made banners throughout the year.



ACTION NEEDED

Garbage cans:

- * Paint and refurbish existing cans
- * Purchase new cans.
- * Review garbage pick-up policies
- * Saturday pick-up.



ACTION NEEDED

Continued maintenance and repair of Downtown infra-structure:

- * Thanks to the City for the improved cleanliness and maintenance to the Riverside Commons area.



ACTION NEEDED

Expand the Riverwalk:

- * 5th Street bridge south to the Farmers Market and old Petrickas.
- * 2nd Street bridge (west side) connection to the Riverwalk.
- * 2nd Street bridge (east side) connection to Carleton stadium.





PROCESS

- ✦ We want to work for YOU!
- ✦ The Council has the Action Squad at its service!

✦ Implement Crosswalk and Speed Reduction NOW!

- ✦ Action Squad will work with staff to identify the next item to implement

- ✦ Dovetail activities with merchants and Downtown committees.
